Sanctuary Camelback Mountain, A Gurney's Resort & Spa, Scottsdale, Arizona

Not only is [Arizona](#)'s Camelback Mountain a premier hiking destination, it's also a scenic backdrop for this resort that has tennis deep down in its roots. Known as the Paradise Valley Racquet Club throughout the 1950s and renamed John Gardiner's Tennis Ranch in 1965, Sanctuary Camelback Mountain, A Gurney's Resort & Spa, continues the legacy of championship training and play with professional coaching, year-round clinics and lessons for beginners and advanced players, and a location that's just a short drive from the Phoenix airport, making midweek escapes and girls' getaways a breeze.
